ANAHITA HAIDARI

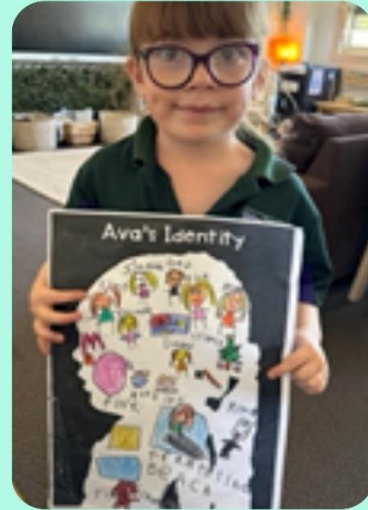
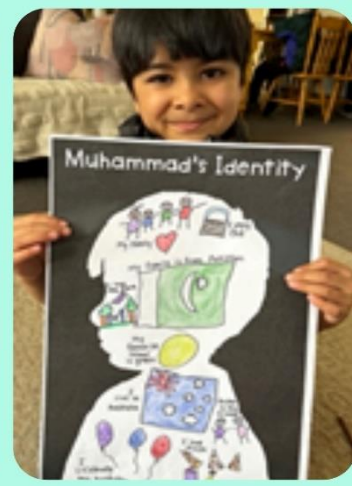
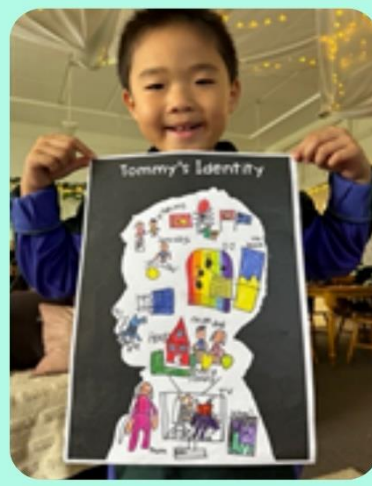
I chose P!NK because I was interested in how she became a singer and what steps she took to become one. I was also curious what P!NK's journey was like.



ZIGGY DEVLIN

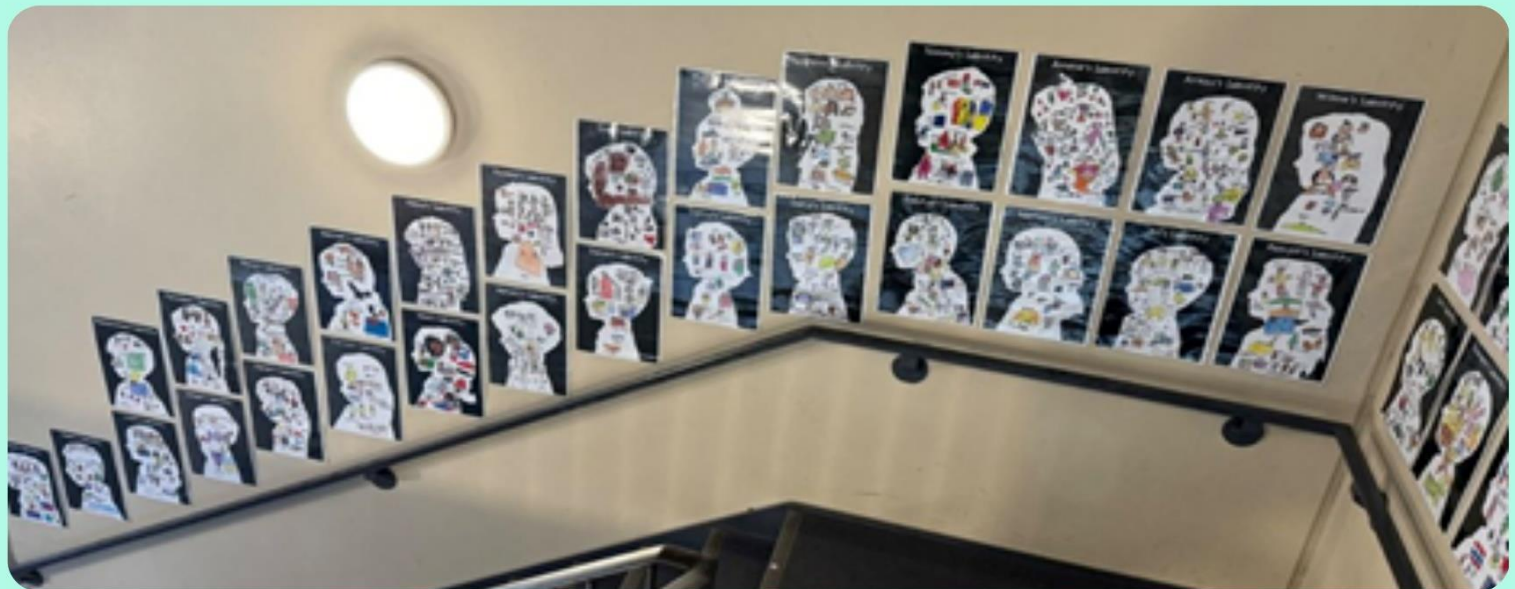
